# Minutes of the November 29th Meeting

22 members present - the meeting called to order at 7:00 PM by President Tom Delaney

Secretary's report - Minutes of the October 25, 2022 meeting were approved as written in the newsletter.

Treasurer's report - debits \$6386.09; credits \$16,705.40; checking balance \$106,966.85.

Trap range update - Tom, Mark and Joe met with John Fritz to look at different road accesses to the farm fields for dirt removal. It was mentioned that a concrete source was found, but with the recent weather it is probably too late to start.

Members only raffle - \$2910 has been collected so far. There will be two guns to pick from: a Berreta shotgun and a Winchester 6.5 Creedmore with scope.

Trapshooting - Winter league starts Thursday, December 1st.

25 Yard Range - Compliance has been good lately but a few issues with targets continue to happen. It is the responsibility of all members to clean up the range after they use it and to center their targets.

Newsletter - in the last month, the club was able to convert 58 members to receive the newsletter electronically.

Membership - 28% of the membership is paid up for 2023. Dues are now due for 2023.

Women's League - Last month's meeting was a social event. Everyone was happy with the activities of the past year and will be ready to start up again next year.

Executive Board - the Executive Board will probably meet again in January.

# A Heartfelt Thanks

As I approached the range to check the zero on my smoke pole one day this fall, it dawned on me what a blessing the range has been over the many years that I have been a member, and all due to the many folks that run the club and maintain the range. It has become one of the "good places" in my life, one of enjoyment, where you start to feel better just driving in there. That day, the mission was to check the zero on my 50 caliber Knight Vision muzzleloader, topped with a 3 x 9 Leupold scope. What a combo. It took considerable experimentation over the years to fine tune the optimal load for this gun, but there was no doubt when we finally got there...a 290 grain plastic tipped copper Barnes Spit Fire EZ-Load sabot with 100 grains of Blackhorn 209 propellant by Western Powders. With this load combo, the accuracy of the Knight Vision is comparable to my Remington 30:06 at 100 yards. I like that is is sighted in to be 2" high at 100 yards, so it is spot on when my target is a little further away than that...still just point and shoot.

It only took three shots to confirm zero that beautiful, sunny, fall afternoon, but as I left, it was with a deep sense of gratitude to all of you that made it possible. Thank you, Have a Blessed New Year and Happy Hunting, Harry D. Menk

## Range Rules:

- 1. You must wear your ID card when on the range.
- 2. Maximum of 2 guests per member are allowed.
- Use paper targets only (no cans, glass, plinking).
- 4. No Paintball guns
- 5. Do not attach targets to the backstop posts.
- 6. No trap shooting; except organized events.
- 7. Be sure bullets are hitting the backstops.
- 8. Do not dig in the backstops.
- 9. All firing must be done from the firing lines at 25, 50 & 100 vards.
- 10. Move the 50-yard target off range when not in use.
- 11. No intermediate targets between established firing lines.
- 12. Do not shoot anything on the ground.
- 13. Pick up your trash, remove targets from backstops, & pick up casings. Leave the area clean & ready for the next member.
- 14. Check unknown people for membership cards.
- 15. Do a **Safety Check** before firing
- 16. Fully automatic weapons are forbidden
- 17. The gate is to be kept locked at all times.
