Volunteer Credit–What Counts?

Members who volunteer to support the club receive reduced dues of \$50 for the next year. So, what counts?

Hours: 8 hours of time will give you credit to reduce your dues to \$50. So, if you work one 4-hour shift at July 4th, you still need to volunteer 4 more hours...or you and a family member could both volunteer, or you could volunteer for two shifts.

35 members present - the meeting called to order at 7:01 PM by President Tom Delaney

Secretary's report - Minutes of the August 29, 2023 meeting were approved as written in the newsletter.

Treasurers report - debits \$11,657.29; credits \$16,944.50; checking balance \$13,675.07 - was approved

New members - three new members introduced themselves

Trap range update - Mark Bauman and Mike Larison updated the club on progress on the new range. With help from the Delano High School trap team black dirt was spread on the range. Grass seed will be planted soon and it will be covered with hay. The light bases are in. Mark has an opportunity to buy two security lights for the parking lot at a reduced cost. Mark is working on getting wiring to the light poles. The DNR has grant money available for shooting ranges. The application needs to be in by the middle of October. It will be for work completed starting November 1, 2023 and completed by June 30, 2024. Brad Spencer will be submitting the application for consideration.

25 Yard Range - The range continues to have its portable targets misused and damaged.

Newsletter - The newsletter went out a little late this month. If anyone is interested in helping out with the newsletter, let Tom know.

4th of July - The club received its share of the profits - \$14,000.00

Summer raffle - The summer raffle has collected around \$6656.00. Brandon Mauer won first prize, Mike O'Connor won second prize and Gary Fischbach won third prize. Steve Bragg and Tom Bipes each sold 41 books of tickets. Gene Hanson sold 32 books.

- Need a team lead/manager to oversee reroofing the range house.



Range Rules:

- 1. You must wear your ID card when on the range.
- 2. Maximum of 2 guests per member are allowed.
- 3. Use paper targets only (no cans, glass, plinking).
- 4. No Paintball guns
- 5. Do not attach targets to the backstop posts.
- 6. No trap shooting; except organized events.
- 7. Be sure bullets are hitting the backstops.
- 8. Do not dig in the backstops.
- 9. All firing must be done from the firing lines at 25, 50 & 100 yards.
- 10. Move the 50-yard target off range when not in use.
- 11. No intermediate targets between established firing lines.
- 12. Do not shoot anything on the ground.
- 13. Pick up your trash, remove targets from backstops, & pick up casings. Leave the area clean & ready for the next member.
- 14. Check unknown people for membership cards.
- 15. Do a **Safety Check** before firing
- 16. Fully automatic weapons are forbidden
- 17. The gate is to be kept locked at all times.
