

# VOLUNTEER CREDIT – WHAT COUNTS?

- Treasurers report debits \$15,061.68; credits \$12,573.25; checking balance \$25,624.72 was approved.
- New members: One new member introduced himself.
- Trap range update The power is to the box on the new trap range. Just waiting for the ground to firm up before resuming work.
- XCEL Energy lease Everything has been cleared off the property. XCEL still has to do restoration of the property as a condition of the lease.
- Range issue There was a complaint of somebody shooting on a Saturday morning. The video was checked at the club and it was determined the shooting did not come from the club.
- Membership The club has 531 paid members, 2 life time members and 80 honorary members . There are around 30 members from last year that have not paid yet.
- Building and Grounds Gene Hanson will be taking over chair of the building and grounds committee.
- Farm house The wood piles have been burned at the farm house.
- Newsletter Aaron Gesell will be taking over the newsletter from Bob Ball. Aaron will reach out to Bob on this.
- Range and Clubhouse reservations Reservations for the Women's Group for the clubhouse on April 18th from 5:00-9:00 pm and the pistol range on June 1 from 12:00-3:00 pm were approved.
- 4th of July Joe Kittok attended a meet and greet for Ambassador candidates for the 4th of July.
- Trap Shooting leagues Winter league has completed. Summer league will start May 1st and 2nd, with a practice night on April 25th.
- Raffles A Sig Sauer 9mm and a Mossberg 12 gauge have been purchased for the upcoming raffle.
- Women's League There is an event coming up on Saturday at the pistol range. The league is getting some improvements done on Cal's range. The league will be using both ranges throughout the year.
- GOCRA/MNGOPAC Legislative updates Dan MacDonald updated the club on new bills that are going through the legislature. Go to whorepresentsmemn to find out who your legislators are in your area. There will be a rally at

- Range outhouse It was requested that the range get a larger outhouse something bigger than what we currently have but not as big as a handicap one. Gene Hanson will luck into what is available.
- Clubs expenses Mike Larison would like the clubs expenses to be reviewed to make sure we aren't overpaying for the services provided. If anyone is willing to help with a review contact Mike.
- The clubhouse needs gutters on the north side Gene Hanson will get some bids for this.
- Snowmobile trail The Delano SnowStormers snowmobile club would like to extend a snowmobile trail from County Line road along and across the clubs property to Farmington Road. It was suggested to have a SnowStormer club member talk to the club at a future meeting regarding this.
- EAW on property there is an Environmental Assessment Worksheet requirement attached to the clubs property from when mining was being considered. The club needs to look into how to get this removed so that future ponds can be built.
- High School trap team volunteer time Mike Larison met with the High School trap team recently. As a condition of shooting this year, each shooter must put in some volunteer hours at the club. This could be working on the club grounds or at the 4th of July bingo stand.
- New Trap Range Clubhouse fundraising Mike Larison reported that club member Jeff Graunke has volunteered to start fundraising efforts for a new trap clubhouse for the new trap range. Many of the details still need to be worked out, but he would contact potential donors for either a one time donation or a commitment of money each year for a period of time. It was suggested to get bids for the building first so that potential donors would know how much we are trying to raise.

Thank you to Coborns for providing lunch for the meeting. March through November are open for lunch volunteers.

There being no additional business, the meeting was adjourned at 7:45 PM.

Rifle and Pistol Ranges are closed during Trap Shooting events, leagues and practices. Watch the range calendar for restrictions/closures due to scheduled events.

#### **Trap Shooting:**

No Hand or portable throwers allowed.

League and Practice Hours: Wednesday & Thursday: 5:45pm-10:00pm

Trap Shooting is only allowed during scheduled events and practice time.

# Be kind to our neighbors-follow the rules!

# Range Rules:

- 1. You must wear your ID card when on the range.
- 2. Maximum of 2 guests per member are allowed.
- 3. Use paper targets only (no cans, glass, plinking).
- 4. No Paintball guns.
- 5. Do not attach targets to the backstop posts.
- 6. No trap shooting; except organized events.
- 7. Be sure bullets are hitting the backstops.
- 8. Do not dig in the backstops.
- 9. All firing must be done from the firing lines at 25, 50 & 100 yards.
- 10. Move the 50-yard target off range when not in use.
- 11. No intermediate targets be-tween established firing lines.
- 12. Do not shoot anything on the ground.
- 13. Pick up your trash, remove targets from backstops, & pick up casings. Leave the area clean & ready for the next member.
- 14. Check unknown people for membership cards.
- 15. Do a Safety Check before firing.
- 16. Fully automatic weapons are forbidden.
- 17. The gate is to be kept locked at all times.
