NEW TRAPSHOOTING CLUBHOUSE!



The Delano Sportsmen's Club is building a clubhouse on the new trap range. This project will be funded solely by donations from individuals and businesses from our community, which is why we're asking for your help.

The clubhouse will be 24'x40' with a 24'x32' covered patio area. Our Phase 1 goal was to reach \$40,000 by the end of October so we can pour concrete this fall – we've reached that goal! Phase 2 will be for materials and labor to put up the Clubhouse exterior shell at a cost of approximately \$80,000. We would like to purchase the materials by January so we can put it up this winter/spring. Phase 3 will be to finish off the inside of the clubhouse – as we could use members who want to volunteer to help, the cost of that final Phase is TBD.

We are asking club members, trap shooters, community members and business owners if they would donate to get this built. Since we started fund-raising 3 weeks ago, we've been blown away by the generosity of the individuals and businesses that have donated money, labor or materials for this project so far. We're currently working with club member Jon DeWitte from Worldwide Steel Buildings on a structure that his company has discounted to the club. Our goal is to build a quality structure that we will be proud of and be cost efficient doing it.

If you have any questions please contact one of us on the Fundraising committee. We'll have volunteer opportunity's available at a later date that we will let you know about. We are also looking for anyone interested in joining the committee to help us raise the funds needed. PLEASE CONSIDER DONATING TODAY. MINUTES OF THE SEPTEMBER 24, 2024 MEETING

40 members present - the meeting called to order at 7:00 PM by President Mike Larison

- Secretary's report Minutes of the August 27, 2024 meeting were approved.
- Treasurers report debits \$7586.72; credits \$5722.00; checking balance \$10,302.24 Trapshooting Checking: debits \$16,860.07; credits \$23,156.00; checking balance \$22,440.59. Both reports were approved.
- New members Three new members introduced themselves
- Membership There are 573 members paid through 2024, 14 members paid through 2025, 2 lifetime members and 86 honorary members.
- Building and Grounds Two dehumidifiers needed to be bought for the clubhouse.
- 4th of July -The core committee meets each month to discuss what they want to do for the 2025 celebration.
- Summer Trapshooting The summer league is over, party night was on Thursday September 19th. Winter league will start on Thursday, December 5th.
- Summer Raffle \$5478.00 was collected prior to the meeting. The drawing was held Alicia White won first place, Sue Glover won 2nd place and Brian Nelson won third place. Steve Bragg sold 58 books of tickets, Paul Klesmit sold 50 and Tom Bipes sold 49.
- Brass recycling 838 pounds of brass was collected this year and the club received \$1774.00 for it. Thank you to Gene and Jan Hanson and Mike Wolf for helping out.
- Legislative report Dave Smith updated the club on the proposed gun control bans that were defeated this year. Thanks to the efforts of MN Gun Owners Caucus all proposed bans were defeated except the binary trigger ban.
- Range -Issues have been minimal. Reminder to watch where you are putting the 50 yard portable target so you don't pull it out so far that it damages the 100 yard target.
- Women's League The Women's League held an event in September at Cal Brandts. It was well attended. Octobers event will be held on Saturday October 5th on the clubs range.
- Range reservations Saturday, October 5th for the Women's League and Tuesday, October 8th for West Hennepin Police were both approved.
- November Lunch Mike Larison asked the club if they
 would like to do a Wild game feed for the November
 meeting. Mike would bring fish to fry, other club members would also bring dishes to share. A motion was
 made and approved to do a wild game feed for the November meeting.
- Club website the club is looking to update the website with payment options, new member information and other features. More to come on this later.
- Mold Inspection Gene Hanson took samples from the clubhouse that were then tested in a lab and mold was found in the utility room and the pump room of the clubhouse. Directions on how to clean it up and what products to use for the cleanup were obtained. The club is looking for volunteers to help with the cleanup.
- Club Audit Club member Roger Larson conducted an audit on the trap shooting checking account. His find-

- ings and recommendations for changes and improvements were given to the club. The executive committee will decide if the club should get an audit done on the clubs general checking account.
- Oktoberfest The crowds were sparse for both days but the bingo stand took in \$644.00. After paying the organizer the club netted \$574.00. \$300 worth of raffle tickets were also sold.
- Non Member sight in day is on Saturday, October 12th.
- Turkey Shoot There were 25 shooters that participated in the turkey shoot. One more than last year. The meal was great with plenty of chicken for everyone.
- Trap Range Expansion & DNR Grant Mike Larison and Dan Kittok met with the banker to sign papers for the approved loan. The DNR Grant information has been submitted and approved. No word on how long it takes to get the check. Concrete work on the third trap range will start on Tuesday, October 1st.
- Trap Range Clubhouse fundraising Jeff Graunke updated the club on the fundraising efforts. He has \$36,000 raised so far for this year for phase 1 with \$5000.00 more committed for phase 2. He also has 5 pallets of insulation supplies worth \$7000 donated for phase 2. Jeff has a meeting with the Delano Legion on Monday and Tim Lemmerman has contacted the hockey association to solicit more donations. If anybody in the club knows of any person or business that would be willing to donate, let Jeff or Tim know. A meeting was held on September 17th to discuss the building design. It was decided to go with a steel structure from Worldwide Steel Buildings. Club member Jon De Witte works for Worldwide Steel buildings and is able to get the materials for the shell discounted by the company. Jon updated the club on the type of building the club decided on.
- EAW on property No additional news. The permitting is still being worked on.

Thank you to Ashley Thienes for providing the meal for the meeting. The October meal will be provided by Vsevolod Tokarev.

There being no additional business, the meeting was adjourned at 7:34 PM.

An Executive Committee meeting was held after the regular meeting. Items discussed were the audit on the general checking account. It was estimated by Roger Larson that it would take 25 to 50 hours to do the audit at a cost of \$1250 to \$2500. After that it would only require 10 hours each year for follow up audits which Roger would use toward his volunteer time. It was approved to get the audit done. Also discussed was securing items in the trap shack so that people using the rifle range can use the trap shack this winter. The refrigerator needs to be locked the thermostat set and locked as well as lockable doors for the shelving. It was also decide to put the clubs name on a list to get a 20 foot shipping container for storage for the new trap range. The cost of the container would be \$1700.

Range Rules:

- 1. You must wear your ID card when on the range.
- 2. Maximum of 2 guests per member are allowed.
- 3. Use paper targets only (no cans, glass, plinking).
- 4. No Paintball guns.
- 5. Do not attach targets to the backstop posts.
- 6. No trap shooting; except organized events.
- 7. Be sure bullets are hitting the backstops.
- 8. Do not dig in the backstops.
- 9. All firing must be done from the firing lines at 25, 50 & 100 yards.
- 10. Move the 50-yard target off range when not in use.
- 11. No intermediate targets between established firing lines.
- 12. Do not shoot anything on the ground.
- 13. Pick up your trash, remove targets from backstops, & pick up casings. Leave the area clean & ready for the next member.
- 14. Check unknown people for membership cards.
- 15. Do a Safety Check before firing.
- 16. Fully automatic weapons are forbidden.
- 17. The gate is to be kept locked at all times.




