VOLUNTEER CREDIT - WHAT COUNTS?

Members who volunteer to support the club receive reduced dues of \$50 for the next year.

So, what counts?

Hours: 8 hours of time will give you credit to reduce your dues to \$50. So, if you work one 4-hour shift at July 4th, you still need to volunteer 4 more hours...or you and a family member could both volunteer, or you could volunteer for two shifts.

MINUTES OF THE OCTOBER 29, 2024 MEETING

41 members present - the meeting called to order at 7:00 PM by public relations liason Tom Delaney

- Secretary's report Minutes of the September 24, 2024 meeting were approved.
- Treasurers report debits \$7224.47; credits \$14,482.80; checking balance \$16,287.67 Trapshooting Checking: debits \$70,660.00; credits \$50,385.90; checking balance \$2166.49. Savings account for new trap clubhouse: Balance 28,480.01 All reports were approved.
- New members One new member introduced himself.
- Membership There are 490 members paid through 2024, 78 members paid through 2025, 2 lifetime members and 87 honorary members.
- Building and Grounds Gene Hanson and a crew cleaned up the kitchen and clubhouse.
- 4th of July -The core committee meets each month to discuss what they want to do for the 2025 celebration. The contract with the carnival is up, the committee is trying to negotiate more outside vendors.
- Trapshooting league Winter league will start on Thursday, December 5th.
- Member raffle \$1160.00 has been collected so far.
- Legislative report Dave Smith updated the club on legislative issues. Dave had voter guides available and information on how to check your legislators voting record on 2nd amendment issues
- Range -The portable targets are getting shot up. Tom Delaney installed a safe for items in the trap shack and a lock was put on the refrigerator. In the next couple weeks, as it gets colder, the trap shack will be open for range users to use while they are shooting.
- Women's League The last event for 2024 was held in October. The league will be taking a break until January 2025. A leadership meeting will be held soon to discuss the schedule for 2025.
- Range reservations Deephaven and Medina police departments have provided their proposed range dates for 2025. A letter was sent out to West Hennepin and Three Rivers Police to get their schedules. The dates were accepted.

- Christmas Party -The club Christmas party will be held on Friday, December 13th from 5:00 -9:00 PM. The club is looking for donations for Christmas gifts. A motion was made and passed to spend \$400.00 on gifts.
- Gun Show The clubs annual gun show will be held on January 11, 2025 starting at 10:00 AM.
- Fence repair Jay Fogelson got an estimate for materials needed to repair the fence. It came in at \$3500.00 \$4000.00. This will be a project that will be discussed in 2025.
- Club website Aaron Gesell updated the club regarding the clubs website. The current website is not secure. Aaron is looking into modernizing it with the potential to maybe pay dues through it and track membership. More information to come.
- Delano High School 2025 Grad Party The Grad Party committee is looking for donations for the party. A motion was made and passed to donate \$300.00 for the party.
- Trap Range Expansion & DNR Grant Concrete on the third range has been poured. No update yet on when the \$25,000 grant money will be received. Gene Hanson and Tom Delaney put a window in the temporary trap shack. Mark Bauman dug in the conduit for the next three lights.
- Trap Range Clubhouse fundraising Jeff Graunke updated the club on the fundraising efforts. Around \$40,000.00 has been collected so far. Blueprints are being made on the building for the permitting process. Mike Larison is working on applying for a grant through the NRA for new trap throwers. He will be asking for three with the hopes of getting at least one.
- Club Audit The Executive Board approved an auditor to review the general fund checking account.
- EAW on property No additional news. The permitting is still being worked on.

Thank you to Vsevold Tokarev and his family for providing the meal for the meeting. The November meal will be a potluck wild game feed.

There being no additional business, the meeting was adjourned at 7:28 PM.

Range Rules:

- 1. You must wear your ID card when on the range.
- 2. Maximum of 2 guests per member are allowed.
- 3. Use paper targets only (no cans, glass, plinking).
- 4. No Paintball guns.
- 5. Do not attach targets to the backstop posts.
- 6. No trap shooting; except organized events.
- 7. Be sure bullets are hitting the backstops.
- 8. Do not dig in the backstops.
- 9. All firing must be done from the firing lines at 25, 50 & 100 yards.
- 10. Move the 50-yard target off range when not in use.
- 11. No intermediate targets between established firing lines.
- 12. Do not shoot anything on the ground.
- 13. Pick up your trash, remove targets from backstops, & pick up casings. Leave the area clean & ready for the next member.
- 14. Check unknown people for membership cards.
- 15. Do a Safety Check before firing.
- 16. Fully automatic weapons are forbidden.
- 17. The gate is to be kept locked at all times.



GOAL



The Delano Sportsmen's Club is building a clubhouse on the new trap range. This project will be funded solely by donations from individuals and businesses from our community, which is why we're asking for your help.

We're currently working with club member Jon DeWitte from Worldwide Steel Buildings on a structure that his company has discounted to the club. Our goal is to build a quality structure that we will be proud of and be cost efficient doing it. The clubhouse will be 24'x40' with a 24'x32' covered patio area. Our Phase 1 goal was to reach \$40,000 by the end of October so we can pour concrete this fall – we've reached that goal! Phase 2 will be for materials and labor to put up the Clubhouse exterior shell at a cost of approximately \$80,000. We would like to purchase the materials by January so we can put it up this winter/spring. Phase 3 will be to finish off the inside of the clubhouse – as we could use members who want to volunteer to help, the cost of that final Phase is TBD.

This is a project where *WE* can make a difference for the next 50 plus years. It will expand the opportunities the DSC will have to offer to our membership. Club members, the Public, as well as the Delano High School trap team, our kids and grandkids will *ALL* be able to benefit from this facility.

The Fundraising committee is asking for your help by donating to get this built. We will keep everyone updated via the club newsletter each month on our progress. If anyone wants to join the committee to help, please reach out to us. We may be sending out emails or contacting members throughout this process.


