### Minutes of the June 27th 2017 Meeting

30 members present - the meeting called to order at 7:00 PM by President Tom Delaney

Secretary's report - minutes of the May 30, 2017 meeting were approved as printed in the newsletter.

Treasurers report - debits - \$4427.84; credits - \$7834.22; checking balance \$50,670.83. Treasurers report was approved. Next month there will be a separate report for the farm income and debits.

One new member introduced himself.

Guest Ashley Bruzek - the clubs queen candidate thanked the club for sponsoring her.

Trap Range - The final site map is being drawn up with an expenditure report on cost. It is hoped that this will be completed by the August or September meeting.

25 yard range - Joe an Tom to work on getting specs to start digging for the wall.

Membership - there were about six new members that signed up this past month. Membership dues are \$150.00 a year if you do not volunteer and \$50.00 if you volunteer eight hours.

There will be an executive board meeting after the July meeting.

There being no additional business, the meeting was adjourned at 7:30 PM. Respectfully submitted, Dan Kittok, Secretary.




### **Raffle Tickets**

### **Volunteer Needs**



### Range Rules:

- 1. You must wear your ID card when on the range.
- 2. Maximum of 3 guests per member are allowed.
- 3. Use paper targets only (no cans, glass, plinking).
- 4. No Paintball guns
- 5. Do not attach targets to the backstop posts.
- 6. No trap shooting; except organized events.
- 7. Be sure bullets are hitting the backstops.
- 8. No digging in the backstops.
- 9. All firing must be done from the firing lines at 25, 50 & 100 yards. Move the 50-yard target off range when not in use.
- 10. No intermediate targets between established firing lines.
- 11. Do not shoot anything on the ground.
- 12. Pick up your trash, remove targets from backstops, & pick up casings. Leave the area clean & ready for the next member.
- 13. No human silhouette targets, except official **police events**.
- 14. Check unknown people for membership cards.
- 15. Do a **Safety Check** before firing
- 16. Fully automatic weapons are forbidden
- 17. The gate is to be kept locked at all times.
